

## Daniel Di Pasquo

Funeral services for Daniel Di Pasquo, serviceman, who was killed in Korea Aug. 23, 1950, will be conducted at 11 a.m. today in Utter-McKinley's Wilshire Chapel, 444 S Vermont Ave. Interment will be in Forest Lawn Memorial-Park. Mr. Di Pasquo, a private in the Army, was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Enrico Di Pasquo, 837 N Edgemont St. He leaves, besides his parents, two sisters, Mrs. Phyllis Pustai and Mrs. Diana Reid. He enlisted in the Army in 1946 and was discharged in 1948. Shortly after his discharge he re-enlisted and after seeing service in Japan was returned here for further training, going back to the front on Aug. 7. He was killed three days after his 21st birthday.
